
METHODOLOGY

- 32 scientific surveys conducted between February 2018 and October 2025 via random sampling from the Florida Voter File.
- Results are representative of Florida voters by age, race, gender, political affiliation, household income, and region of the state.

Believes that historical accounts of the Holocaust are generally accurate – not exaggerated, and not a myth (among those aware of the Holocaust)










Believes Jews deserved or hold some responsibility for what happened to them in the Holocaust










Believes Jews have used the Holocaust to advance their agendas or goals in the following areas









Believes Hamas was at least somewhat justified in their October 7 attack on Israel and its citizens (results consistent with national survey findings by other researchers)




Experimental design: Each respondent randomly assigned to see only 1 of 2 messages:

"It is fair for <u>Ukraine</u> to retaliate against <u>Russia</u>..."

B "It is fair for <u>Israel</u> to retaliate against <u>Hamas</u>..."

March 2025 (results largely identical to those fielded in August 2024)








Experimental design: Each respondent randomly assigned to see only 1 of 2 vignettes describing harassment on a college campus. The only difference between vignettes was the identity of the victim.

Experimental design: Each respondent randomly assigned to see only 1 of 2 vignettes:

"A <u>Palestinian</u> college student blocked a <u>Jewish</u> student from entering a classroom building, and yelled, 'go back to where you came from!"

"A Jewish college student blocked a Palestinian student from entering a classroom building, and yelled, 'go back to where you came from!"


